
# UPDATED ASSESSMENT MAPP 2.0 FRAMEWORK:

MAPP 2.0 is streamlined and focuses on broad community engagement. It includes three assessments to provide a full picture of our region:

- Community Partner Assessment (CPA): Provides
  a structure for all community partners to look
  critically at their individual systems, processes, and
  capacities; and collective capacity as a network of
  community partners to address health inequities.
- Community Status Assessment (CSA): Collects quantitative data on the status of communities from trusted local, state, and national sources.
- Community Context Assessment (CCA): Is a
  qualitative data tool to assess and collect data
  through three domains: community strengths and
  assets, built environment, and forces of change.


